I. Call to Order

Dr. Stolarz, council chair, called the meeting to order at 2:00 pm and attendees reintroduce themselves.

II. September 8, 2017 meeting minutes

III. Dental Education

A. Dean's Report

Dean apologized for his delay with IUPUI water main break that closed the dental school today. March 2, 2018 is the scheduled celebration of the James Fritts Dental School Addition. ADEC is installing 125 new dental units beginning in December. Succession planning is continuing with several faculty including Dr. Guba, associate dean for clinical affairs, etc. IUPUI early retirement offers were at 27 and now down to 7. Student Outreach Clinic was able to get a grant for \$100K from Gannett and the SOC is working to secure some new facilities in the area. Fort Wayne IPFW transition and asked IKDDS to advise about the programming at the location. Dean has asked for feedback on dental lab tech programming. Request from the Dean about a Dental Summit on allied dental auxiliaries with Hygiene, Assistants and Dental Laboratory

B. Follow up on Welcome Reception tonight with D1 at Howl at the Moon
Numbers were 66 individuals for event that begins at 7 pm at Howl at the Moon. There was a noise issue. Council liked the idea of looking at the former Bugg's Temple venue and looking at August or September dates. Maybe look at late August.

IV. Continuing Education

A. 2017 Fall Academy

Dr. Alan Jeroff presented on November 10, 2017 for an all day lecture on Oral Surgery, anesthesia for General Dentists to 209 Academy members.

V. Dental Practice

- A. Prescription Guide project -Council planning to update and print a new prescription guide (\$20 and print 1,500 guides). Council spent majority of time reviewing the guide page by page. Significant updates were made and IDA staff will update and forward to pharmacist and council for review.
- B. Extended invitation to the Indiana Dental Laboratories for Jan. 19th, 2018 meeting. The IDLA is being asked to bring a “state of union” update on the dental laboratory industry.

VI. New business

- A. New IDA Committee Structure update. Council briefly heard about the upcoming changes to the council committee structure. IDA staff reminded the council members about the November 10th deadline for application.
- B. ADA Health Policy Institute Report Oral Health Care System: Indiana. IDA staff shared a report from ADA Health Policy Institute. Dr. Rector emphasized that Iowa Midwest meeting and a Dentaquest Oral Health 2020 meeting that discussed equity of care versus equality of care. Concerns about IDA and this council to solve the Medicare Medicaid disparity of care. Dean discussed the IUSD move to IPFW and Evansville expansion. Dean asked the state for a \$5,000,000 grant for taking care of the Medicaid populations. The capitation proposal was too much at the time for the state. The dean suggested that this “node” model and expansion that would help with the access to care issues. Dean would like to ask for \$10 million ask with additional \$2 M per site that opens. Downtown, Ft. Wayne (IPFW), Evansville, future Gary, other locations. Dean discussed not just students but also service contract dentists provided 24 hour. This would be a appropriation with state budget working on loan forgiveness options. Suggestion of FQHC designation which is a different model. The turbulent Healthcare environment will drive a lot of this work.
