All officers must be active, life, or retired members in good standing of both the Indiana Dental Association and American Dental Association.

SELECTION CRITERIA (Top desired characteristics and credentials for nominees):

- 1. Public Speaking Skills:** The Vice must feel comfortable and confident when leading a discussion, calling a meeting to order, or moderating delegates.
- 2. Conflict Resolution:** The Vice President must feel confident resolving disputes or other disruptions during a House or Board meeting. While no formal training in this area is needed, the ideal candidate will be willing and able to moderate disputes during meetings.
- 3. Team Player:** The Vice President must collaborate with and support the President in the administration of his/her duties.

TIME COMMITMENT:

- Attend all Board meetings, House of Delegates meetings and any other special meetings.
- Represent the IDA with local components as assigned.
- Manage special requests and projects and delegated by the President.
- Assume the office of President for the remainder of the unexpired term of office in the event of the resignation, death or removal of the President or due to the failure or inability of the President to perform the duties of the office.
